


# Multi-Portal Architecture

#### The Problem


 Maintain similar but not identical functionalities for various clients.



#### **Two Bad Alternatives**

- Copy-paste-modify: clear code separation, but common parts have to be maintained manually.
- 2. Introduce "casuistics": create lots of "IF" statements that make the code inmaintainable.

### **Approaches**

#### Management / Sales

- Rise attention of sales/management.
- Reflect cost of variant management by price.

#### **Technical**

- Inheritance and similar techniques.
- "User exits" with client specific "exit" implementations (=> SAP).
- Design templates specific to customer.
- Well planned parameterization of modules from the beginning.






Separate directories for each portal . .
